

# **Energy-Efficient Cool Roof**

### Get up to a \$200 Rebate per 1000 Square Feet



A cool roof reflects more of the sun's rays and can help keep the surface of your roof much cooler in the summer sun. Less heat is transferred to the interior of your home, so it takes less air conditioning for you and your family to stay comfortably cool. Now when you install a cool roof, the size of your roof determines your rebate amount. Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is offering up to \$.20 per square foot, so that

means you can get a rebate of up to \$200 per 1,000 square feet.

- Reduce heat island effects in cities and suburbs
- Help reduce air pollution and smog
- May lengthen the lifetime of your roof
- Save on electricity bills during the hot months by reducing AC load

#### How to Get Your Rebate

- You must be an active residential or multifamily PG&E customer
- Installation must take place at a PG&E service address
- Your home must be in Climate Zone 2, 4, 11, 12, or 13
- Make sure you purchase and install qualifying roofing products for this rebate. Review the <u>PG&E Catalog and Rebate Application</u> for full details

- Sign and mail your completed application with proof of purchase to PG&E within 90 days of purchasing your product

## **Buyer's Tips**

When you are selecting a roofing contractor, remember to do the following:

- Contact a licensed C-20 contractor to get an installation proposal for the qualifying products. You can also contact the Contractors State License Board (CSLB) at 1-800-321-CSLB or go to <a href="http://www.cslb.ca.gov/">http://www.cslb.ca.gov/</a> for more information.
- To account for roofing overhangs, make sure to ask your contractor to convert the "roofing square footage" into the actual square footage and indicate this information on the final invoice.
